## **ANOTHER FIRST... A SHEET REPLACEMENT CHANGEOVER**

A fantastic discovery was made. The 5¢ value had a changeover in the sheet replacements. This is the first time to my knowledge that a range of 50,000 replacements has a signature changeover within the range, it is indeed a very rare occurrence. Way to go Canadian Banknote (CBN)! None of the coupons in the range mentioned here was seen in my area.

It appears as though another large cleanup of old stock has occurred at CBN. There has been a shortage of  $5 \not \in 10 \not \in$ 

The 50,000 range of notes sampled is 0493300000-0493349999. In each range of 1000 notes 350 sheet replacements have been found, including 316 CTC S31-Ba11 replacements as well as 34 CTC S30-Ba09, all in the same range.

This would mean that 15,800 CTC S31-Ba11 replacements are already out there in the range 9001250000-9001299999. There is also 1,700 CTC S30-Ba09 in that same range. Another odd occurrence.

It was previously thought that this range belonged to the S30-Ba09 range exclusively. Now we have two different replacements occurring in this same range with these changeovers. There will be 50 sets of changeover notes in this range of 50,000 notes. The changeover occurs between sheet 90012nn290 (CTC S30-Ba09) and sheet 90012nn291 (CTC S31-Ba11) All of these sheets were not inserted in numerical order, but spread out haphazardly through the full 1,000 notes. The changeover notes/sheets were in the last block of 100 notes (from 900 to 999) where the first 34 sheet replacements were CTC S30-Ba09 and the last 8 CTC S31-Ba11 sheet replacements were found. So far the lowest CTC S30-Ba09 found is 90012nn257, it would be nice to know if they started at 90012nn000. If you find lower, please let me know.

I could not print the entire range of 1000 notes to show you were each sheet was found as it would have taken pages and pages. The complete breakdown of the full 1000 note sampling will be in the next Hi Lo specialized update.

In the above table each 1000 notes in the entire 50,000 note range should be a near duplicate of the above, some ranges have had some single note replacements in the 900130nnnn

range thrown in but should not affect the other ranges of sheet replacements to any degree. Only about a dozen of these single note replacements have been found so far. All of the notes found in this range are CTC S30-Ba09. Possibly there could be a changeover in this series also. Again, time will tell. #### GAS BAR CTC8-D WITH BROWN SERIAL NUMBER...

A note not often seen or discussed is the CTC8-D 50¢ note with brown ink serial number. This variety occurred during the last stage, when the notes were numbered. From the notes seen, this ink was used briefly in the range from 1,600,000 to 1,700,000. These notes have not been seen in any other range. I suspect this may have been due to

operator error, using a mix of 2 different inks in the same container, or selecting the wrong ink and catching the mistake early before too many notes were numbered. My scan shows serial

# 1670559 with brown ink and the normal Orange-Red ink used on serial # 1686124. I could not bracket the notes any closer, maybe someone out there can. The difference in the color is quite pronounced. See the scan.

If this variety is not due to errors in the printing I would be delighted to hear or see your comments as to its

authenticity. I sure would like to see some AU or Uncirculated notes bracketed closely of this variety. Thanks to Bill Cuff for supplying these notes. Direct inquiries to Ifontaine@shaw.ca



# FOLLOW UP ON THE JUSTIFICATION ISSUE

Thanks to all the members who have added to the Justification article in the October edition of the Collector. Thanks to some digging by Bill Cuff # 337 it looks like we can confirm that CBN crossed over from non-justified to justified print when they changed plates.

The 5¢ notes changed when they went from 2009 to 2010. Originally it looked like they changed as the prefix changed, but with all the coupons we're looking at now, it seems the change came somewhere early in the 04 prefix run. With most other coupons, the transition was made with the new plates when the signature was changed from Pasternak to Marrone.

The 10¢ and 25¢ changed between 2008 and 2011 which was also a signature change. The 50¢ and \$2.00 changed between the 2007 and the 2012 plates, also a signature change. The \$1.00 changed between the 2006 and the 2012 plates, also a signature change. There's no explanation at this point why a new plate was created during the middle of the run of the 5¢ coupons. This change just isn't making sense to me as yet. Any thoughts from you??

# GAS BAR NOTES THROUGH THICK AND THIN...

An absolutely fascinating area in printing is where a different thickness of paper is sometimes used during a printing. The notes shown below are a consecutively numbered pair of Uncirculated CTC 9-D1 50¢ notes recently acquired from Bill Cuff. The first note (Serial # U5867066) is on the normal paper and the second note (Serial # U5867067) is on a much thicker paper. See image below. The beauty of this pair is that they are consecutive and the difference in thickness is obvious. This has also occurred on other values of the CTC 9 issue particularly the 5¢ value.

When batches of paper are made, a constant thickness is sometimes difficult to maintain particularly at the start of a production run. It appears that some sheets or rolls of the produc-

tion run, were not of the normal thickness, however since these were not for Currency or postage stamps the exact parameters were not strictly adhered to. During a printing run of notes, when a machine runs out of paper and a new batch is fed into the machine, there may be some slight differences in the thickness of the paper.

Some of you may remember the multiplier coupons of the West and East dated (Nov 26, 2000) where the coupon from the West is on thick cardboard paper and the Eastern version on normal thinner paper. See image below.

# **CANADIAN TIRE LOSES TWO STARS**

With great love and respect the family of Fred Sasaki announced his passing on Wednesday, January 29, 2014, in his 95th year. Predeceased by his wife Naka and daughter Nana, his father Shuichi, mother Midori, his sisters Sumi, Cannie and Audrey.



Fred is also one of the founders and eventually a resident of the Momiji Seniors Centre. A

leader in his community Fred received numerous awards from many organizations for his generous and determined volunteer work.

Fred came to Canada at 10 months of age from Hiroshima, Japan. He graduated from the University of BC with a Bachelor of Commerce through correspondence from Calgary while his family was interned during WWII. After the war Fred started working in the stock room at Canadian Tire riding on roller skates. Eventually Fred worked his way up to Vice President of Finance at Canadian Tire. His signature can be found on the infamous Canadian Tire Money during his time as a senior executive.





The club was saddened to learn of the passing of Hugh Leopold Macaulay. We'll remember Hugh as the co-signer of the CTC S15 series of notes - the first series to be issued combining both the Gas Bar notes and the early Store series notes. Hugh Macaulay died peacefully in his 89th year at his retirement home in Toronto. A grad of

UWO, Hugh was a WWII vet in the Canadian Navy, a PR rep at Ford, owner of York Mills Pontiac Buick in Toronto and a political advisor to the Ontario PC Party. Hugh held board positions at Ryerson Polytechnic, York University and Ontario Hydro, but will always be remembered as the Chairman of the Board of Canadian Tire from 1984 to 1993. Following the resignation of Dean Muncaster in June 1985, Hugh was appointed interim COB until 1987 when Dean Groussman was appointed COB. Macaulay stepped down as Chairman in 1994, but remained on the board of directors until 1998. Hugh's signature also appears on the \$2.00 note issued as the CTC \$16 in 1992.



#### **GAS BAR & STORE NOTES WITH MISSING SERIAL NUMBERS...**

Ron Wilkie began a study on notes that have missing serial numbers. The list, compiled by Ron, is quite comprehensive and I will develop it further as we go along. I made a table of the notes Ron suspected existed or possessed in catalogue order and added any that were not mentioned.

One example of where the cause, was not sheets stuck together, is the Gas Bar CTC 2-C issue where a good number of 3¢ coupons were printed without a serial number. Whether this was an error or deliberate is unknown. (Could have been a rookie printing on that day or week.)

For modern coupons, missing serial numbers occur when 2 sheets are stuck together during the numbering process so one sheet of 50 will not get numbered. When the sheets are cut and made into bundles one of the packets of 100 coupons will actually have 101. One sheet was stuck to another but

came loose during the cutting and bundling process.

It is important to keep the bracketing notes to indicate exactly between which notes the missing serial number was found as you can see below for the S28-E07, S29-C07 and S31-C11. The only way to find them like this, is in sealed bundles. If you find a sequence in a sealed bundle then that will mean there are at least 50 in that particular batch of 50,000 coupons. See below an example of a CTC S29-C07

Of course not everyone is a collector of these notes so several will be found that are circulated however it will be unknown where the error occurred. Collectors who have notes without serial numbers that are not listed here, please contact me or any other member that is in contact with me.



# **MORE GHOST PRINTS...**

Since my last article on "Ghost prints" more have come into my possession recently thanks to Bill Cuff who has collected and saved a lot of excellent material over the years.

The first one is a CTC S17-C, the 10¢ Red value. On the second pass the 10¢ in the left side losange is doubled downwards. It is very prominent as it has a blurry look compared to the right side. All other details are normal. The warning label on the left side also has an additional detail that is not readily seen but there is a red fiber running through association. (See fig 1)

The next note of interest is a CTC 9-A2 with inverted prefix letter, Serial # S5937635. (See fig 2). Note the pronounced doubling on the value. This would be a variety caused during the second pass where the values and the black ink are

printed. In this note the right side values are doubled substantially more than the values on the left.


The next type of doubling that I have seen is on a Gas bar coupon, CTC 8-A2, with inverted S, Serial # S4558690. (See fig 3). This note has doubling in the Green security part of the printing which would have been done in the first pass. Note that all areas of the Green security printing are doubled. To see it more clearly have a look at CTC, it is doubled to the left. The security printing is doubled on other CTC 8 and 9 gas bar values but I cannot show them all here.

If you have a lot of coupons to look through see what you can find. The more pronounced the doubling the better, if it is minor then it will be difficult to see even with a magnifier. Direct inquiries to Ifontaine@shaw.ca




