I am quite sure that most collectors hope that one day they will fall upon one of these elusive coupons and finally be able to fill that hole in their collection.

Wouldn't it be interesting to get a better idea of exactly how many of these coupons are actually out there? Most members report their highs and lows to Louis Fontaine and he puts them in the hi-lo listings.

We do not know the printing procedures of the British American Bank Note company at the time this series was being printed, so it is impossible to determine how many coupons were printed on a sheet back then. The serial numbers known

would suggest that some of these replacements were part of a sheet replacement, but it is only a guess at this time.

I need your help to update this list of known notes. If you have one I would really appreciate it if you took the time to send me the serial number and let me know if you have bracketing notes for your replacement. Do not worry, your anonymity will be respected if you wish it to be.
