


## How to distinguish the 1 & 2 Void varieties on the CTC S11-B1 & CTC S11-E1 series



THE 1 VOID VERSION



THE 2 VOID VERSION

The word **VOID** is designed into the background color just above the slogan “Cash Bonus” to the left of the CTC triangle logo and above “Billet-Bonis” to the right. The word **VOID** is made up of fine ( — ) lines at an angle of 35 degrees. The letters are 3/16 of an inch or 4mm high. The use of a magnifying glass to see the letters is recommended for both varieties.

The second version gets a bit more complicated, the word **VOID** appears twice on either side of the **C.T.C.** triangle. The top **VOID** is near the top of the note but the second **VOID** is underneath the slogans “Cash Bonus & Billet-Bonis” They are also made up of fine ( — ) lines but the angles are different for each word. The lines on the top left one run at an angle of about 105°, the bottom left at 140°, the top right at 125°, and the bottom right at 170°. The letters are about 9/32 of an inch or 7mm high.
